* Ἡ βιβλιογραφία αὐτὴ ἔχει συγκεντρωθῆ διὰ τὸ Δελτίον τῆς Ἑταιρείας Νεοελληνικῶν Σπουδῶν (τοῦ Ἰουνίου 1973) καὶ δὲν πρέπει νὰ χρησιμοποιοῦνται ἀπὸ οἰονοδῆ-ποτε ἀσχιολογούμενου μὲ παρόμοια συλλογὴ βιβλιογραφίας χωρὶς τὴν ἀπαιτούμενη ἔγκρισιν. Ὁ ἀριθμὸς καταχωρί-σεως τῶν διδακτορικῶν διατριβῶν, ποὺ βρίσκεται στὸ τέλος τοῦ ἀρθροῦ, ἀναφέρεται στὸν ἀριθμὸ ποὺ εἶναι καταχωρημένος διὰ Dissertation Abstracts (Ann Arbor, Mich.), ἀντιθέτως, δὲν συμμετέχουν στὸ Dissertation Abstracts ὅλα τὰ κολλέγια καὶ πανεπιστήμια, καὶ γι' αὐτὸ μερικεὶς διατριβὲς δὲν ἔχουν καθόλου ἀριθμὸ καταχωρί-σεως.

Ἐκείνη, ἀπὸ ὅ,τι γνωρίζω, δὲν ἔχει γίνεῖ μέχρι σήμε-ρα συστηματικὴ συγγραφὴ μελετῶν, ταξινομήση ὕλης καί, γενικά, συλλογὴ τίτλων διατριβῶν καὶ δοκι-μίων, ποὺ ἔχουν ὡς θέμα τους τὴν Ἑλλάδα καὶ ποὺ ἔχουν ὑποβληθῆ σὲ ἀμερικανικὰ καὶ καναδικὰ πα-νεπιστήμια. Μόνο σποραδικεὶς καὶ συμπτωματικὲς παραπομπὲς ὑπάρχουν, ποὺ, ὁμως, δὲν ἀποτελοῦν συστηματικὴ βιβλιογραφία τῶν διατριβῶν.

Τέτοια ἐργασία εἶναι ἀδύνατον νὰ βρεθῆ, ἀκόμα καὶ στὶς διάφορες εὐρωπαϊκὲς χῶρες, ὅπου, ἀπὸ πολ-λὲς δεκαετίες, ὑποβάλλονται διατριβὲς μὲ ἑλληνικὰ θέματα σὲ διάφορα πανεπιστήμια καὶ ἰδρύματα.

Σὲ ἄλλες χῶρες, συμπεριλαμβανομένων καὶ τῶν ἀνατολικῶν, ἔχει ληφθῆ μέρημα γιὰ τὴν σύνταξη βιβλιογραφικῶν ἐργασιῶν αὐτοῦ τοῦ τύπου, ὥστε νὰ διευκολύνεται τὸ ἔργο τοῦ μελετητοῦ καὶ τοῦ ἐρευ-νητοῦ. Στὴν Ἑλλάδα δὲν ἔχει ἀκόμη ληφθῆ μέρι-μα γιὰ τὴν ἐκτέλεση τέτοιου εἶδους ἐργασιῶν.

Συνήθως, γιὰ κάθε πνευματικὴ δραστηριότητα, εἶναι ἀπαραίτητη ἡ ἰδιωτικὴ πρωτοβουλία.

Κάνοντας, λοιπόν, μὴ ἀρχῆ, καταπάσθηκα μὲ τὴ βιβλιογραφία αὐτὴ, μὲ σκοπὸ νὰ βοηθῶ τὸ ἔργο τῆς Ἑταιρείας Νεοελληνικῶν Σπουδῶν (Mod-ern Greek Studies Association) τῆς Ἀμερικῆς καὶ τοῦ Καναδά. Φιλοδοξία τῆς Ἑταιρείας αὐτῆς εἶναι νὰ συμπληρωθῆ ἡ βιβλιογραφία ὅσο τὸ δυνατόν πληρέστερα, μὲ τὴ βοήθεια ὄλων, ὅσοι γνωρίζουν κάτι σχετικὰ μὲ τὰ θέματα αὐτά. Ἡ ἴδρυσιν αὐτῆς τῆς Ἑταιρείας, ὅπως καὶ μίᾶς παρόμοιας ποὺ ἰδρύθηκε πρόσφατα στὴν Ἀγγλία, ὀφείλεται στὴν ἰδιωτικὴ πρωτοβουλία καὶ στὶς θυσίες στὶς ὁποῖες ὑπεβλή-θησαν πολλὰ ἄτομα ἀφιλοκερδῆς.

Ἐλπίζω πῶς, ὅταν τελειώσῃ ἡ ἐργασία αὐτὴ, θὰ μποροῦν, ὅσοι σπουδασταὶ θὰ θέλουν τὸν δόξαν νὰ ἀσχοληθοῦν μὲ τὴν Ἑλλάδα, νὰ βρίσκουν τὶς ἤδη ὑπάρχουσες ἐργασίες καὶ νὰ βοηθοῦνται στὶς μελέτες τους, χωρὶς νὰ ἐπαναλαμβάνουν τὰ ἴδια πρά-γματα ἢ νὰ ἀσχολοῦνται μὲ παραπλήσιες μὲ τὶς δικές τους ἐργασίες. Τὶς διατριβὲς θὰ μπορῆ κανεὶς νὰ τὶς προμηθεύεται ἂν ἀπευθύνεται εἴτε στὰ Dissertation Abstracts International, Ann Arbor, Michigan, USA, εἴτε στὰ ἴδια τὰ πανεπιστήμια, εἰδικὰ δὲ στὶς βιβλιοθήκες τους.

Καὶ τώρα, σχετικὰ μὲ τὴ βιβλιογραφία αὐτὴ, θὰ ἤθελα νὰ κάνω ὀριζόμενες παρατηρήσεις. Ἄν προσεξῆ κανεὶς τὶς χρονολογίες, κατὰ τὶς ὁποῖες ὑπεβλήθησαν οἱ διατριβὲς, θὰ δῆ πῶς τὸ ἐνδιαφέρον γιὰ τὰ ἑλληνικὰ θέματα ἀρχίζει, κυρίως, μετὰ τὸν Β' Παγκόσμιο Πόλεμο, καὶ ἰδίως στὴ δεκαετία τοῦ 1960, ὁπότε καὶ οἱ μελέτες ἀναφέρονται σὲ πῶ ἐι-δικευμένα θέματα. Σὲ πρῶτο πλάνο, βρίσκονται οἱ μελέτες οἱ ἀναφερόμενες σὲ θέματα οικονομικὰ καὶ πολιτικὰ, πρᾶγμα ποὺ σημαίνει πῶς στοὺς κλάδους αὐτοὺς ὑπάρχουν ὄχι μόνο πολλοὶ ὑποψήφιοι, ἀλλὰ καὶ εἰδικευμένοι εἰσηγηταί, ποὺ ἐπιμελοῦνται τὶς διατριβὲς αὐτές. Ὑστερα, ἀκολουθεῖ ἡ Ἱστορία

καὶ ἡ Κοινωνιολογία. Ὅσον ἀφορᾷ τοὺς κλάδους τῆς Λογοτεχνίας, τῆς Φιλολογίας καὶ τῆς Γλωσσολογίας, ὁ ἀναγνώστης θὰ προσέξῃ πῶς, παρ' ὅλον ὅτι οἱ τίτλοι εἶναι κάπως εἰδικευμένοι καὶ περιωρισμένοι σὲ ἓνα θέμα ἢ σὲ ἓνα συγγραφεύα, οἱ σχολές ποὺ χορηγοῦν τὰ πτυχία τὰ κατατάσσουν σὲ ἄλλους κλάδους καὶ σειρές μαθημάτων, ὅπως, π.χ., Συγκριτικὴ Λογοτεχνία, κλπ.

Ἄξιζει νὰ σημειωθῇ ὅτι ἔχουν ἐκπονηθῇ πάρα πολλές διατριβές γιὰ τὸν Ἑλληνισμό τῆς Ἀμερικής, καθὼς καὶ κοινωνιολογικὲς ἔρευνες σχετικὰ μὲ τὶς ὁμάδες κατοίκων στὴν Ἑλλάδα. Ἐπίσης, ἐπιδεικνύεται ἐνδιαφέρον γιὰ τὸ Βυζάντιο, ἰδιαίτερα δὲ γιὰ θέματα Ἱστορίας, Τέχνης καὶ Λογοτεχνίας.

Λίγα λόγια γιὰ τοὺς συγγραφεῖς-ἔρευνητάς: πολλοὶ εἶναι Ἕλληνες. Μερικοὶ ἀπ' αὐτοὺς προέρχονται ἀπὸ τὴν Ἑλλάδα, ἄλλοι ἔχουν γεννηθῆ ἰσχυρὰ Ἀμερικῆ (ὁμογενεῖς) καὶ ἔχουν λίγη ἢ σχεδὸν καμμιὰ σχέση μὲ τὴν Ἑλλάδα. Ὑπάρχουν, ἐπίσης, καὶ πάρα πολλοὶ ξένοι, Ἀμερικανοὶ κυρίως, ἀλλὰ καὶ Καναδοί, καθὼς καὶ ἄλλοι ἀπὸ διάφορες εὐρωπαϊκὰς χώρες, ποὺ δὲν ἔχουν καμμιὰ σχέση μὲ τὰ ἑλληνικὰ πράγματα. Αὐτὸ εἶναι κάπως ἐνθαρρυντικὸ γιὰ τὸ μέλλον, γιατί ἔτσι ἡ Ἑλλάς, ὡς γεωγραφικὸς χώρος, πολιτικὴ μονάδα καὶ, γενικά, ὡς θέμα μελέτης, ξεφεύγει ἀπὸ τὸ περιθώριο ποὺ ἦταν ὡς τώρα καὶ ἀπὸ τὴν τοποθέτησίν της στὴν κατηγορία τῶν ὑπαναπτύκτων χωρῶν. Αὐτὸ σημαίνει πῶς, ἂν ὁ ἔρευνητὴς μπορῇ νὰ βρῇ ὑλικὸ καὶ στοιχεῖα ἔξω ἀπὸ τὸν ἑλληνικὸν χῶρον, δὲν θὰ εἶναι ἀπαραίτητο νὰ εὐρίσκειται στὴν Ἑλλάδα: συγκεκριμένα, ἂν βιβλιοθῆκες, ἰδρύματα καὶ ἄλλα πνευματικὰ κέντρα ἐφοδιασθῶν ἀπὸ τὴν Ἑλλάδα μὲ ἀρχεῖα, βιβλία, φυλλάδια, ἐφημερίδες, κλπ., καὶ οἱ ἔρευνητὲς μποροῦν νὰ ἐξυπηρετοῦνται εἴτε μὲσφ βιβλιοθηκῶν τῶν πανεπιστημίων τῶν, εἴτε μὲσφ ἄλλων πνευματικῶν κέντρων, γραφείων, κλπ., τότε εἶναι βέβαιο πῶς θὰ ἀυξήθῃ τὸ ἐνδιαφέρον γιὰ τὰ ἑλληνικὰ θέματα.

Τελειώνοντας, θὰ ἤθελα νὰ ἐνημερώσω τὸ ἀναγνώστη σχετικὰ μὲ τοὺς τίτλους καὶ τὴν κατάστασιν τῶν διατριβῶν ἐπὶ πτυχίῳ στὰ ἀμερικανικὰ πανεπιστήμια. Στὴ βιβλιογραφία αὐτὴ ἔχω περιλάβει, μαζί μὲ τὶς διδακτορικὰς διατριβές, καὶ τὰ Masters Essays, ποὺ ἔχουν ὑποβληθῆ ὡς τώρα γιὰ τὸ πτυχίον Μ.Α., κυρίως στὶς θεωρητικὰς ἐπιστήμες. Ὅμως, δυστυχῶς ἢ εὐτυχῶς, πολλὰ ξένα πανεπιστήμια καὶ κολλέγια ἀρχίζουν, σιγά-σιγά, νὰ μὴ χορηγοῦν τέτοια πτυχία, ἀλλὰ νὰ περιορίζονται μόνο στὰ Ph. D. (διδακτορικὰ). Συνεπῶς, τὸ μέλλον, μόνο διδακτορικὰς διατριβές θὰ ἀναφέρονται στὴν Ἑλλάδα, ὅπως καὶ σὲ κάθε ἄλλο θέμα. Ἐπίσης, στὴν Ἀμερική καὶ στὸν Καναδὰ δὲν ἀπαιτεῖται νὰ ἐκδίδονται καὶ νὰ δημοσιεύονται οἱ διατριβές, ὅπως ἀκριβῶς γίνεται στὶς εὐρωπαϊκὰς χώρες. Ὅσες ἀπὸ τίς διατριβές ἔχουν ἤδη κυκλοφορήσει

ὡς βιβλία καὶ ἔχουν ἐλκύσει τὴν προσοχή μου, ἔχουν συμπεριληφθῆ ἰσχυρὰ βιβλιογραφία αὐτὴ, περικλειόμενες μέσα σὲ ἀγκύλες. Πολλοὶ σπουδασταὶ, ἀφοῦ πάρουν τὸ πτυχίον, εἴτε ἐπεκτείνουν τίς διατριβές τους, εἴτε χρησιμοποιοῦν ἀποσπάσματα ἀπ' αὐτές, γιὰ νὰ τὰ παρουσιάσουν ὡς ἄρθρα, ὅποτε τὸ περιεχόμενο μπορεῖ νὰ εἶναι τὸ ἴδιο μὲ τὴς διατριβῆς, ὁ τίτλος ὁμοῦ δὲν μένει ὁ ἴδιος. Στὴν περίπτωσιν αὐτὴ, θὰ εἶναι μάταιο γιὰ τὸν ἔρευνητὴ νὰ ψάχνῃ γιὰ τὸν τίτλο τῆς διατριβῆς στὴ νέα μορφή ποὺ τῆς ἔχει δώσει ὁ συγγραφεύς.

Ἡ βιβλιογραφία αὐτὴ ἀποτελεῖ ἀπλῶς μιὰ ἀρχὴ. Σκοπεῖ, στὸ μέλλον, νὰ τὴν ἐπεκτείνω καὶ νὰ συμπεριλάβω, κατὰ τὸ δυνατόν, τὴν ἀρχαία Ἑλλάδα, τὸ Βυζάντιο, τὴν Τουρκοκρατία, καὶ ὅλους τοὺς τίτλους γιὰ τὴ σύγχρονη Ἑλλάδα, ὅστε νὰ ἀποτελέσῃ μιὰ βιβλιογραφία μὲ κριτικὴ παρουσίασιν κάθε διατριβῆς χωριστά.

Although the bibliography of Masters Theses and Doctoral Dissertations in the area of Greek studies printed below is by no means complete, it is to date the most exhaustive work yet compiled. Mr. Giannaris' labors have been compounded by the fact that many persons neglected to give the number of pages of their paper, the date of presentation, and even the university at which it was given. Thus it was impossible to include their papers in this Bibliography. Furthermore many members of the Association failed to respond at all to his requests for information. Lack of space prohibits topics previous to the eighth century A.D., but it is hoped that in the next issue of the BULLETIN there will be room to include this valuable information on the earlier period. Mr. Giannaris thanks all members of the Association who responded to his requests for information, and asks that everyone assist in this important bibliography by sending to him the exact title of the paper, the institution at which it was presented, the date, and the number of pages, so that in the near future a truly complete Bibliography of Theses and Dissertations can be published.

MANTATOPHOROS BIBLIOGRAPHY

The Bulletin of Modern Greek Studies in England, MANTATOPHOROS, presented in its first issue, November 1972, eleven pages of bibliographical material on Modern Greek language, literature, history and geography. It is particularly useful in the number of entries by Greek authors, whose names and contributions in the field are not readily accessible to the English-speaking scholar. Book literature is in many respects the most difficult type of material to search thoroughly. Various catalogues and indexes will lead the searcher to books dealing with the broad subject of the inquiry; but the specific subject of the inquiry will probably be much narrower, otherwise the inquiry would probably have been satisfied, initially at least, by the book itself.
