## THE FRANGOCHIOTIKA BOOK COLLECTION IN THE JESUIT LIBRARY OF GREECE: CHARACTERISTICS AND PARTICULARITIES

**ABSTRACT:** This workshop presentation explores the Frangochiotika collection housed in the Jesuit Library of Greece, which comprises 92 unique publications with a rich history tied to the Aegean Islands and the Catholic Church. The collection, developed over four decades by Fr Sevastianos Freris and supported by contributions from various donors, includes works primarily published in the nineteenth century that reflect religious themes and cultural exchanges within the Ottoman Empire. Key items range from grammars and spiritual texts to liturgical booklets, showcasing the diversity of printed material available to the clergy. This contribution emphasises the importance of preserving and cataloguing such publications to facilitate access for researchers and promote the significance of religious literature in the region.

In December 2023, the library and archives of the Jesuit Fathers had the pleasure to host one of the sessions of the joint workshop on Frangochiotika, co-organised with the National Hellenic Research Foundation and the Austrian Academy of Sciences. On this occasion, I grabbed the opportunity to present the main characteristics and particularities of the collection of printed books held in our library, shedding light on the spiritual and cultural life of the Catholic communities in the Aegean Sea and the broader Ottoman Levant. Our library houses 92 Frangochiotika publications, a chronological list of which appears in the appendix.

The library and archives of the Jesuit Fathers have been operating since 1970, and contain a large number of rare and unique books since the early sixteenth century, archival collections containing materials of the various missions in the Eastern Mediterranean as well as parts of the archives of the school they ran through the centuries. These include incunabula, antiquarian books, and documents that detail the history of the Jesuits in Syros, Tinos, Naxos and Santorini from the sixteenth century onwards. This remarkable collection owes much to the efforts of Fr Sevastianos Freris and the late Fr Gabriel Maragos.

Fr Freris' profound passion for collecting, organising and preserving printed materials that had been previously disregarded as worthless led to the building of a comprehensive collection of pamphlets, brochures, prayer books, short-lived publications, icons, invitations to private or public events as well as various

types of printed texts. Outstandingly, this includes the Frangochiotika collection meticulously amassed over more than four decades through individual research but also various donations. A great bulk of these items were discovered in the monastery of Loutra in Tinos, while some originate from the neighbouring island of Syros. Others were either purchased from booksellers or donated by local Catholic families who had used them for their own religious purposes. Finally, some of them were rescued from donation boxes or storage bins alongside old newspapers. They were meticulously collected, preserved and made accessible by our library and archive for scholarly research as well as for the use of a broader educated public with an interest in the subject of Catholic piety in Greece and the Eastern Mediterranean.

Historian Philippos Iliou, who had been a frequent reader in our library, assisted Fr Freris in cataloguing these works and incorporated many of them, including some of the Frangochiotika, into his Greek bibliography of the nineteenth century.<sup>1</sup>

### *Our Collection*

Our Frangochiotika collection is organised according to the criteria established by Fr Markos Foskolos: religious content, place of publication within the Ottoman Empire and publication date ranging from the sixteenth to the early twentieth century.<sup>2</sup> The collection comprises 92 publications, with 89 dating from the nineteenth century and three from the mid- to late eighteenth century. Remarkable items within this collection include a brief grammar book for learning Italian, Latin, vernacular Greek and Turkish published in Padua in 1781, a Jesuit work on spirituality published in Rome in 1746 as well as a booklet by Tommaso Velasti on the Sunday Mass and festival worship (printed in Messina, Sicily, in 1753).

Most of the nineteenth-century publications were printed in Smyrna and Constantinople; some of them were however published also in Paris, Padua, Venice, Rome, Vienna, Trieste and Ermoupoli. Forty of the publications from Smyrna were printed in eight different printing houses, though a few lack identification of the printing house. Examples include the Ionian Printing

House of N. Stamenis, Daveronis and Sougiolli, Vidori Brothers, Damianos, and Patricios Markopoulos.

In Constantinople, 22 publications were printed by establishments such as St Benedict's Bookstore, M. de Castro, Indicatore Bizantino, A. Zellich and Courier d'Orient Printers. Other publications came from K. Dhimidhu and G. A. Melistaghus in Syros, the Armenian Fathers' printing houses in Vienna and Trieste, and the Chambre de Commerce in Paris.

The publications vary in size and format. Most of them do not exceed 20 cm in height, making them convenient for daily use by the clergy. Some lack title pages, complicating their description, while others bear marks of (usually unknown) private ownership, such as those belonging to some Mrs Antoinette. Despite their fragile condition and previous attempts at preservation, they remain accessible for study.

### *Reflections and Conclusion*

Libraries in Greece that hold Frangochiotika publications have a responsibility to highlight this unique aspect of religious literature in the Ottoman Levant through modern research tools and improved preservation techniques. Apart from the printed books, manuscript materials contained in the rich archives of the Jesuit missions notably include abundant correspondence as well as a number of documents used for teaching and learning that are written in the Greek vernacular language using the Latin script. Scholarly collaborations could very helpful for identifying and cataloguing yet-undiscovered or unclassified publications, as well as digitising and organising this large corpus, which presents a challenge for librarians who strive to balance two duties: that of their physical preservation and that of the accessibility of those materials for scholarly research.

It is noteworthy to remark that during my five-year-long service at the library and archives of the Jesuit Fathers, apart from scholars, two individuals asked and used Frangochiotika books, both of whom spoke Greek as a foreign language. This underscores the original purpose of these publications: to be understood and utilised by the faithful. In a community with numerous religious foreigners eager to learn Greek, new forms of communication might emerge, echoing the historical significance of Frangochiotika and sparking interest among future researchers.
