


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Editorial

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Open Schools Journal for Open Science Special Issue Articles from the OSOS Portuguese Final Conference



This special issue of the Open Schools Journal for Open Science gathers the works presented during OSOS Portuguese Final Conference, that took place on the 14th February 2020, at the Pavilion of Knowledge - Ciência Viva, in Lisbon (Portugal). In this event, Portuguese teachers and students, representing schools from all over the country, shared their OSOS projects, that ran during school years 2018/2019 and 2019/2020. The issue includes 37 posters in Portuguese with explanatory abstracts in English.

In Portugal, more than 100 teachers and 2500 students participated in OSOS - Open Schools for Open Societies.
