

## GUIDANCE FOR REGISTRATION WITH THE JOURNAL “DELTION OF THE CHRISTIAN ARCHAEOLOGICAL SOCIETY”

To submit your article to the *Deltion* of the Christian Archaeological Society, **you must first register with the journal as an Author** (URL: <http://ejournals.epublishing.ekt.gr/index.php/deltion/user/register>) and then follow the steps described below.

### Complete the following required fields:

1. **Form Language:** Choose the main language in which the article is written from the dropdown menu. Your first and last name will appear with the first language selected.
2. **Username**
3. **Password**
4. **Repeat password**
5. **Validation:** Enter the characters which appear on the screen in the corresponding blank field.
6. **First Name:** The **First** and **Last Name** of the author are registered in only one language, that in which the article you plan to submit is written.
7. **Last Name**
8. **Email**
9. **Confirm Email**
10. **Affiliation (Capacity, Institution, Department):** In case there are two or three components to Affiliation, these should be separated by an intervening semicolon (;), e.g. Postgraduate researcher; Aristotle University of Thessaloniki; School of History and Archaeology.
11. **ORCID ID:** This is an international researcher attribute that can be acquired with a simple registration and at no cost at [www.orcid.org](http://www.orcid.org). It is a very useful way to attribute work to authors and to connect information online.
12. **Country**
13. **Working Languages:** you may complete more than one working language, e.g. Greek and English.
14. **Register as:** You may select both fields, **Reader** and **Author**. Please note that registration as an Author is required to submit your article online.

**PLEASE NOTE:**

- The **First** and **Last Name** of an author are entered in only one language, as detailed above. The other details are provided **in two languages**. To do this, first fill in your information in the language in which the article is written and click **Submit** (right beside the field **Form Language**) to define the language. Then provide the information in a second language chosen from the dropdown list, click on the **Submit** field and fill in your information, except for the first and last name of the author, which remain as they are in the first-choice language. Please do not save in between the two languages. To complete this process, click on the field **Register**.
- One of the two languages you select **must** be English because this is required by the **Open Journal System (OJS)**. The above process for providing information in another language to the OJS also obtains for the submission of the metadata for articles (see the online submission guidance).
